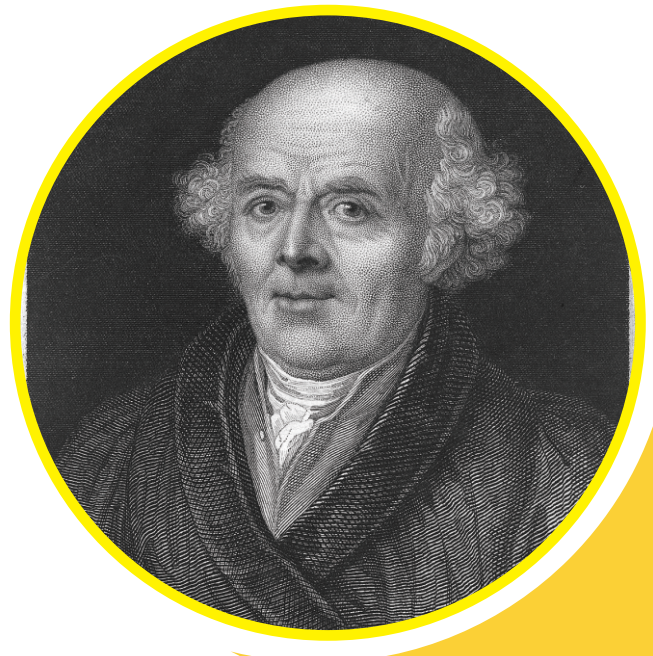

COURSE & ELIGIBILITY

Course : Under Graduate – BHMS



Eligibility

NEET qualified candidate must have passed 10 + 2 (Science) or equivalent examination from a recognized Board/ Council or University and must have obtained 45% marks. An appearing candidate may also apply but their candidature shall only be valid when they obtain minimum pass marks in the examination before counseling.

The candidate must attain the minimum age of 17 years on or before 31-July of the current year.

Selection Process

Candidates short listed based on NEET examination & have to appear in the 1st round of counseling/2nd round of counseling and mop-up round be held for candidates listed in the waiting list provided that there are seats vacant after the 1st round or 2nd round of counseling by the Govt. authorized board/ council.

Prospectus and Application Form

Application form would be available at Devki Mahabir Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Hospital, payable at Garhwa, for Rs.500/- in case or Thought post by bank draft Rs.-550/- or it can be download from college website.



DEPARTMENTS

As per the Minimum Standards of Education norms laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, Devki Mahaveer Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Hospital has the following departments which are fully equipped and having all the facilities as required in the MSE norms.

HUMAN ANATOMY

Human Anatomy is the science which deals with the structure of the human body.



Initially, Anatomy was studied mainly by dissection. Dissection is a technique to cut, to open & see various structures which make up the human body structure.

The scope of modern anatomy has become very wide because it is now studied by all possible techniques which can enlarge the boundaries of the anatomical knowledge.

PHYSIOLOGY AND BIOCHEMISTRY

Physiology is the scientific study of normal function in living systems. A sub-discipline of biology, its focus is in how organisms, organ systems, organs, cells, and bio-molecules carry out the chemical or physical functions that exist in a living system.

Physiology aims to understand the mechanisms of living and how living things work. Human physiology studies how our cells, muscles and organs work together, how they interact. Physiology, sometimes referred to as the "science of life", looks at living mechanisms, from the molecular basis of cell function to the whole integrated behaviour of the entire body.



HOMOEOPATHIC MATERIA MEDICA

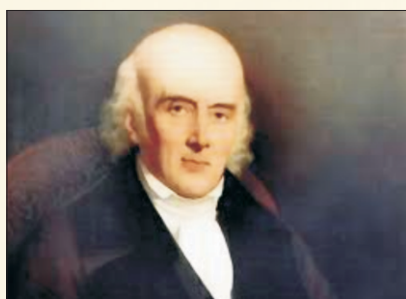
Homoeopathic Materia Medica is one of the core subjects in the BHMS curricula and is taught in First, Second, Third and Final BHMS. Our Materia Medica is differently constructed as compared to other Materia Medica. Homoeopathy considers that an essential and complete knowledge of the drug action as a whole can be obtained only by experimenting the drugs on healthy human beings so that it is possible to view all the data in relation to the psychosomatic whole of a person.



HOMOEOPATHIC PHARMACY

Homoeopathic pharmacy is one of the basic fundamental Homoeopathic subjects. The major difference between Homoeopathic and Allopathic system is their pharmacology.

The subject is dealing with how the medicines are procured and prepared from various sources. It also gives a detailed explanation about various processes and knowledge regarding the Selection, Collection, Combining, Compounding, Potentising, Standardising, Preserving & Dispensing of the Homoeopathic Medicines; is imparted through this subject.



ORGANON OF MEDICINE & HOMOEOPATHIC PHILOSOPHY

Organon of medicine is the subject which imparts education to the students in regards to principles and Philosophy of Homoeopathic discipline. This monumental book was authored by the founder of Homoeopathy Samuel Fredrick Christian Hahnemann who was 200 years ahead of his time. The book gives practical guidelines regarding practice of Homeopathy to

all practicing Homoeopaths.

PATHOLOGY, BACTERIOLOGY & PARASITOLOGY

The subject of Pathology is concerned with the Study abnormal changes that occur at the cellular level. These changes or alteration in the physiological processes cumulatively result in the disease process.



These abnormal changes can be caused by Bacteria, Virus, Fungus, Parasite or Allergens. They can also be caused by Heredity, Habits, Life style, Addictions, over drugging or they can simply be because of Auto-immunity. Exposure to any such causative results in Signs and Symptoms. Along with these some of the normal values of certain Physiological Parameters are also altered. Through Pathological analysis these alterations can be measured and a probable diagnosis can be obtained.

FORENSIC MEDICINE & TOXICOLOGY

The broad goal of the teaching of undergraduate students in Forensic Medicine & Toxicology is to produce a physician who is well informed about medicolegal responsibilities in Practice of Medicine. She/he will also be capable of making observations and inferring conclusions by logical deductions to set enquiries on the right track in criminal matters and connected medicolegal problems. She/he acquires

knowledge of law in relation to medical practice, medical negligence and respect for codes of medical ethics

SURGERY

The subject of Surgery and Homoeopathic Therapeutics is included in the syllabus of 2nd and 3rd B.H.M.S. The final exam is conducted at the end of 3rd B.H.M.S.

As homoeopathy has proved its efficacy in treating many pre and post surgical cases, the sound knowledge of Surgery is essential for a very good medical practice.



The Department of Surgery is well equipped with all the surgical instruments, and fully functional Major and Minor operation theatre with recovery rooms. There is a separate OPD for surgical Cases at the Hospital.



OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY

This subject covers the normal & abnormal happenings in females, especially in reproductive period.

Obstetrics includes all events & complications during pregnancy and also neonatology meaning care & management of the new born baby.

Gynecology deals with all the other female problems like infections, tumors & sterility.

PRACTICE OF MEDICINE

Practice of Medicine & Homoeopathic Therapeutics is one of the subjects taught in the institute from second year B.H.M.S. till Fourth Year B.H.M.S. The examination is conducted in Fourth B.H.M.S. as syllabus framed by C.C.H. New Delhi & H.N.G.U. Patan.



HOMOEOPATHIC REPERTORY & CASE TAKING

Case taking is a stepping stone to repertorisation. This is a step, which facilitates the gathering of the data pertaining to what is to be cured in the diseased person. It is said that "A well taken case is half cured".

It is an accepted axiom in the principles of total quality management that an awareness of the problem, the recognition of the problem, & the admission of the existence of that problem takes one of half the road donor towards solving that problem. With the same analogy, the importance of proper case taking & its faithful recording can never be

over stressed.

COMMUNITY MEDICINE (PSM)

The Subject is part of Final year B.H.M.S., it's also known as the Preventive and Social Medicine Commonly now termed as Community Medicine, as name suggest it's classical study of Social aspect of Diseases through which diseases pattern is studied in connection with it's distribution and determination. Also Social, emotional, financial, cultural effects on Health and Diseases Development, progression of disease and Health related issue in society. It deals with not only medicine but to impart knowledge to the students about the diseases prevention, nutrition, hygiene, addiction and precautionary measure associated with the disease.



FACILITIES

Team of Experienced, Highly qualified, dedicated, skilled teaching staff from Homoeopathic specialization, as well as allied medical qualification with various designations are working to provide good knowledge beyond the curriculum.

Teaching Facilities

Method of teaching is beyond blackboard by use of Audio-visual aids- such as LCD projectors, Slide projectors, DVD, TV, Over Head Projectors, Smart board, etc. Ultimately is to make it more effective, informative and for better understanding

Library

Books are the lifeblood of any educational system. They are treasures of knowledge and must be used effectively. The college library has adequate no. of books, journals (Indian & Foreign), Supplements & other learning material for students. The books are available as per CCH/NCH norms. Internet connectivity and online information sources are also available. There is a separate reading room for students and faculty members. Xerox machine, Fax machine & Computers are available in the library for student's use. Library timing & its functions are guided by the rules & regulations of the librarians.

Guest Lectures

In Medical Science Clinical knowledge is more important hence Guest Lectures, Seminars, Workshops are being conducted by inviting skilled resource persons from outsourcing.

Study monitoring

Monthly test examinations are being conducted for every subject regularly and monitored over student's progress. In each semester examination is being conducted for all the subjects and marks are obtained in the test examination and semester examination together are being calculated for eligibility to appear for University examination.

Academic Competitions

By rotation Class Room Seminar is conducted among students for every subject and every class to improve their skill of presentation and explore their hidden characters.

Study Tours

Tours are conducted as part of Curriculum for students associated by Staff to Witness Homoeopathic Manufacturing Pharmaceutical Companies, Homoeopathic Health & Research institutes. Also attending National, International Seminars, Conferences.

Projects

Students are being further trained by allocating Projects of academic nature guided by the staff which is helping the students for overall improvement.

Practical Training

Practical Training is provided at the student level as per Curriculum at laboratories which are 100% equipped as per Regulations framed by the University and apex body. Additional training is provided during their Internship period. Student witness Post Mortem at District Hospital and Community Health Centre officially.

Teaching Up-gradation

Regular monitoring is made on teaching skills, the methodology of teachings. Each teacher adopts Teaching Planner as per calendar and microteaching teaching plan. Once in a month monitoring is done inter departmentally and by the head of the institute.

Rules & Regulation for Students

1. Students are expected to use only courteous & polite language and behave with decorum, with the faculty members and the staff of the College/Institute.
2. Students shall avoid using any insulting, inciting, threatening language when talking with fellow students and should abstain themselves from violence.
3. Students shall not talk or act in any manner outside the institution in a way that would bring disrepute to the College/Institute.
4. The students shall be regular and punctual in attending classes and all activities connected with the College/Institute. As per university/Board/Council rules 75% attendance is mandatory to appear in final examinations. However for Internship (as applicable) required attendance (as per norms of Council/University/Board) is compulsory.
5. Gathering in groups at road entrance, exit and pathways is strictly prohibited.
6. The students shall observe strict silence in the class irrespective of the presence or absence of the faculty member.
7. Students should not leave the class during class hours or attend it late under the pretext of paying fees, visiting the library etc.
8. Students are expected to read notices/circulars displayed on the College/Institute Notice Board. Ignorance of not reading any notice/circular thus displayed shall not be accepted as an excuse failing to comply with the directions contained in it.
9. All vehicles should be parked in the allotted place. Vehicles found parked in unauthorized places shall be impounded.
10. While attending College/Institute functions, the students will conduct themselves in such a way as to bring credit to themselves and to the institution/College.
11. Spitting, smoking and throwing bits of paper inside the College/Institute campus/Hostels are prohibited.
12. Students are forbidden from entering the College/Institute office and the staff rooms during unspecified hours.
13. Students are prohibited from damaging the building or any other property of the College/Institute/Hostel in any way. The cost of any damage so caused will be recovered from the students collectively if the responsibility for it cannot be fixed on any individual or group of individuals.
14. Representation of complaints and grievances may be made individually to the Principal through the Class Teacher concerned or Discipline-cum-Grievance Committee.
15. No meeting/function of any kind shall be held in the College/Institute premises without the written permission of the Principal.
16. No notice of any kind shall be circulated among students or displayed on black boards or on notice board, no information or report should be sent to press or broadcasting agencies without the permission and approval of the Principal.
17. The Principal will deal strictly with students who play a leading part, by organizing or assisting, in strikes.
18. The students are expected to take up all assignments, tests and examinations of this College/Institute/University seriously and would try to perform the best.
19. Misconduct during examination, production of false information or documents for admission purpose and the failure to return loaned materials or settling debts with the College/Institute would be seriously dealt with.
20. In this campus various courses are conducted simultaneously and hence, students should observe SILENCE in the campus.
21. Ragging and Eve Teasing are considered as crime and strictly prohibited by an act promulgated by the Government with the penalty of Rs.10,000/- and two years' imprisonment. If any student indulges in any form of ragging or Eve-Teasing inside the College/Institute premises or outside, he/she will be summarily expelled from the College/Institute. Students are required to submit Anti Ragging affidavits **Annexure III & Annexure IV** in prescribed format before the commencement of classes.
22. Each student of this College/Institute must possess Student Identity Card with his/her photograph affixed on it, duly attested by the Principal. The students must compulsorily wear the Student Identity Card inside the College/Institute Campus.
23. Students shall come clean, tidy and modestly dressed in College/Institute Uniform. Students not in College/Institute Uniform would be marked as absent for that particular day. If non-adherence to this rule is reported against a student often, severe action may be initiated against him/her. Students must use aprons while working in lab and hospital.
24. Use of mobile phones within the class is strictly banned. Violation of this rule by any student would result in impounding of the Cell phone and strict disciplinary action against the student.
25. Annual fees are payable in one stroke as prescribed by the College/Institute on or before the scheduled dates to avoid fine. Fine will be charged as applicable for the late fee submission.
26. Fees once paid are not transferable / adjustable or refundable under any circumstances.
27. No student shall be allowed to appear for the university examinations unless he/she paid all his/her dues and completed his/her work assignments to him/her along with minimum 75% attendance in all classes/Lab work.
28. Hostlers are not allowed to use electric / gas stoves, heaters, etc in hostel rooms except in designated places.
29. Loitering in the Hostel campus during the class hours will not be allowed and if found disciplinary action may be initiated.
30. Visitors are allowed only in guest room of the hostel between: 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m for hostellers. Visitors are not allowed beyond the visiting area. No outside Guest/Students will be allowed inside the hostel.
31. Students during their stay in the hostel will be governed by the College/Institute administration rules.
32. In Hostel, Food will be served only in the designated Dining Hall(s) and only during the specified timings. Wasting food & water will not be encouraged.
33. Smoking, Alcohol & Narcotic consumption is strictly prohibited in and around the College/institute and Hostel premises. Strict action will be taken against offenders by the College/Institute administration or disciplinary committee.
34. Late comers in Hostel will be penalized.
35. Students should not involve themselves either directly or indirectly in any form of politics, Unions or any other such formation either inside or outside the College/Institute during their period of study. If a student fails to comply with this regulation, strict disciplinary action will be initiated against the student as deemed fit by the Disciplinary committee/Principal/Management which may even result in the rustication of the student from the College/Institute.
36. The management reserve the right to change any rules & provisions as and when required.
37. In case of any dispute or legal action will be only Honorable Civil Court, Garhwa (Jharkhand).
